A child aged about two years, daughter of Mrs John Mason, of Bailieston, met with a peculiar accident on Thursday week, which has unfortunately resulted in her death. It seems that on the day in question the little girl was running about playing, with a nail about two and a half inches in length in her mouth when she fell on her face, the [line obscured] and the palate considerably.

After some difficulty the mother succeeded in removing the nail, and the little sufferer was brought in to see Dr Heard, who prescribed for her.

On Saturday, however, symptoms of blood poisoning set in, and the child died after intense suffering on Monday morning.
