DEATH.

DARROCH.—On the 13th inst., at Whroo, John, the dearly beloved husband of Mary Darroch, aged 36 years. His end was peace.

Mr John Darroch's many friends will regret to learn that he passed away at his residence, Whroo, on Friday last.

The deceased, who was a member of the firm of Darroch Bros., the well-known sawmillers, was born at the White Hills 36 years ago, and had resided in the district ever since.

The remains, which were interred in the Whroo cemetery on Sunday, were followed to the grave by a large concourse of people, the cortege being preceded by the local brass band playing the Dead March in Saul.
