An old resident of Whroo, Mrs W. Allan, died at her late residence on Saturday morning last, after a long and painful illness, of consumption, to which disease her late husband also succumbed about 15 months ago.

Mrs Allan was much respected, and leaves behind her a large family, some of whom are very young.

The funeral, which took place at the local cemetery on Sunday afternoon, was very largely attended, almost every inhabitant of Whroo being present.

The Rev. R. L. Reed officiated at the grave, hymns being sung by the local choir, and the funeral arrangements were conducted by Mr G. Anderson.

Ellen Allen, not Allan, is shown in the records, buried at this time.
